

Stratitec, Inc. Trademark Guidelines for CPUBuilders™ Trademarks and Stratitec™ Trademarks.

A. The CPUBuilders Trademarks. Stratitec, Inc. (“Stratitec”) is the owner of the following registered trademarks: CPUBuilders™, the CPUBuilders logo¹ and the CPUBuilders wrench²(collectively “CPUBuilders Trademarks”). No party is authorized to use any of the CPUBuilders Trademarks without either: (1) first obtaining express written permission from Stratitec to use the CPUBuilders Trademarks; or (2) limiting use of the CPUBuilders Trademarks in strict accordance with the provisions set forth in Section C, Trademark Permissions below. Stratitec will not allow any party to use the CPUBuilders Trademarks or any similar mark as a trademark or otherwise in connection with the sale or distribution of any other party’s products or to use the CPUBuilders Trademarks or any similar mark in any manner that might cause confusion in the marketplace.

B. The Stratitec Trademarks. Stratitec is the owner of the following trademarks: the name “Stratitec” and the registered trademark on the Stratitec logo³ (collectively “Stratitec Trademarks”). No party is authorized to use any of the Stratitec Trademarks without first obtaining express written permission from Stratitec to use the Stratitec Trademarks. Stratitec will not allow any party to use the Stratitec Trademarks or any similar mark as a trademark or otherwise in connection with the sale or distribution of any other party’s products or to use the Stratitec Trademarks or any similar mark in any manner that might cause confusion in the marketplace.

C. Trademark Permissions. Stratitec grants a limited and restricted trademark license to use the CPUBuilders Trademarks to the following: Educational Institutions, Not-For-Profit Organizations, Linux User Groups, Affiliated Individuals, Personal Users and Certain Business Users, but only if the use is limited in accordance with the provisions of

this Section C.

Educational Institutions, Not-For-Profit Organizations, Linux User Groups and Affiliated Individuals. If you are an educational institution, a not-for-profit organization, a Linux User Group, or an individual affiliated with or employed by any of these organizations, Stratitec grants a limited trademark license with respect to the CPUBuilders Trademarks for the specific and limited use with the non-commercial redistribution of the open source software, developed by Stratitec for use in connection with CPUBuilders Trademarks, in the form you electronically downloaded it from Stratitec's FTP site or as copied from an original disk shipped with a Stratitec product. Stratitec considers non-commercial redistribution to be any distribution for which you charge no more than the cost of replicating the CD and where the redistribution is not accompanied by a sale of any commercial product. If any copies are to be distributed to individuals outside your organization, either the label or an accompanying printed document must indicate that: (a) the distribution is provided without any warranties (unless you elect to provide those warranties); and (b) this distribution does not include support (either technical or developer) services from Stratitec, but that such services may be purchased from Stratitec separately. If you are making copies available for electronic download from your site, these same statements must be prominently displayed prior to any download being initiated. You are permitted to redistribute source code, but only if you: (1) do not use the CPUBuilders Trademarks or the Stratitec Trademarks in any manner; (2) comply with the GNU General Public License as set forth in Section D, GNU General Public License; and (3) comply with the Trademark Guidelines set forth herein.

Personal Users and Certain Business Users. If you are an individual or business (including all subsidiaries of such business) and you only intend to use and actually use the open source software, developed by Stratitec in connection with CPUBuilders Trademarks, for your own personal use or, in the case of a business, intend to use and actually use the open source software, developed by Stratitec in connection with CPUBuilders Trademarks, only internally, in the original form delivered by Stratitec (or by its authorized distributors) or with modifications provided by Stratitec, then Stratitec grants a limited license to use the CPUBuilders Trademarks for such limited purpose, including use of CPUBuilders Trademarks on all such internal copies. Please note that without a separate support contract from Stratitec, only an original purchased copy comes with installation support. You are permitted to redistribute source code, but only if you: (1) do not use the CPUBuilders Trademarks or the Stratitec Trademarks in any manner; (2) comply with the GNU General Public License as set forth in Section D, GNU General Public License; and (3) comply with the Trademark Guidelines set forth herein.

All Other Parties. All other parties who desire to use CPUBuilders Trademarks or Stratitec Trademarks must contact Stratitec by sending an email to licensing@stratitec.com in order to discuss possible licensing arrangements.

D. GNU General Public License. Stratitec allows third parties to replicate the open

source software, developed by Stratitec in connection with CPUBuilders Trademarks, under the GNU Public License ("GPL"), but only if (1) you do not use any of the Stratitec Trademarks or the CPUBuilders Trademarks; (2) qualify for the restricted license to use CPUBuilders Trademarks under Section C, Trademark Permissions, set forth above; or (3) obtain written permission from Stratitec.

Subject to the above conditions, as a licensee under the GPL and other applicable copyright licenses, you may replicate open source software, developed by Stratitec in connection with CPUBuilders Trademarks, from Stratitec, whether downloaded from an FTP site, other electronic download site, or copied from a CD originally produced by Stratitec, and market the replicated product in accordance with the terms of the copyright licenses. However, because Stratitec does not charge for the open source software itself, and because portions of the open source software were originated by third parties, it would be confusing to consumers if you identify such a replicated product as a Stratitec or CPUBuilders product and, if you do so, you are hereby given notice that such conduct is done without any authorization from Stratitec and is expressly forbidden under U.S. copyright laws, U.S. trademark laws and applicable statutes.

If you do not qualify under and comply with the Section C, Trademark Permissions above, but want to produce and market copies of open source software, developed by Stratitec in connection with CPUBuilders Trademarks, as it was developed and released by Stratitec without modification, you may do so, provided that you (1) comply with all applicable copyright licenses for the software; (2) comply with the Trademark Guidelines set forth herein; (3) do not name, brand, advertise, label or otherwise identify your product by reference to any of the CPUBuilders Trademarks or Stratitec Trademarks; (4) refrain from indicating in any manner that your product originates from, is sponsored by or approved by Stratitec; and (5) use a different trademark for your product that will not cause confusion with any of the CPUBuilders Trademarks and/or Stratitec Trademarks.

As a licensee under the GPL and other applicable licenses, you may make modifications to the open source software, developed by Stratitec in connection with CPUBuilders Trademarks, and market the revised product provided that you: (1) comply with all applicable copyright licenses for the software; (2) comply with the Trademark Guidelines set forth herein; (3) do not name, brand, advertise, label or otherwise identify your product by reference to any of the CPUBuilders Trademarks or Stratitec Trademarks; (4) refrain from indicating in any manner that your product originates from, is sponsored by or approved by Stratitec; and (5) use a different trademark for your product that will not cause confusion with any of the CPUBuilders Trademarks and/or Stratitec Trademarks.

E. Right to Revoke or Amend Trademark Permissions and GNU General Public License. Stratitec reserves the right to revoke or amend the following by providing thirty (30) days advance notice of any revocation or amendment through publication of such notice on its website: (1) the restricted trademark license to use the CPU Builders Trademarks as more particularly described in the above Section C., Trademark

Permissions; and (2) the license to replicate the open source software developed by Stratitec in connection with the CPU Builders Trademarks and the terms and conditions of such use, as more particularly described in the above Section D., GNU General Public License.

NOTE: Some portions of the software in the open source software, developed by Stratitec in connection with CPUBuilders Trademarks, may be proprietary products. If you wish to distribute proprietary products, you must obtain a license to do so from the owner of that proprietary application software. Please do not copy any proprietary application software unless the license for that software permits you to do so or you have obtained a separate license from the owner of the proprietary application software.
